Mercury is the closest of the planets to the sun and so near to Earth. This planet is often called a morning star. This's because Mercury shines brightly in the early morning just before the sun rises. It has also called an evening star for the same reason. If you moved to Mercury, you would not weigh as much as you do on earth, because Mercury is smaller and so has less gravity. If you weigh 30kgs on earth, you would weigh only about 12kgs on Mercury. There is almost no air on Mercury. Its temperature is 800 and at night is 300. Then are no seas, rivers or lakes on it.so you can't live on Mercury but there are wonderful things there. It goes around the sun every 88 Earth days and its days are so long. Each day in Mercury is 58 ½ Earth days long.
